7. SCRUTINEERING

For this event in-person scrutineering will take place subject to social distancing, mask wearing and sanitation protocols being adhered to.

Self-declaration scrutineering form to be sent out with the event supplementary regulations and entry form.

Pre-race, in-person scrutineering will take place on Thursday 23 September 2021 from 14H00 -20H00

Competitors only are to take their vehicles, personal safety gear and GPS to the scrutineering area along with a copy of the self-declaration scrutineering form submitted when entering the event. The self-declaration scrutineering form must be a printed copy. Only one person per race vehicle is permitted in the scrutineering area.

Bikes and Quads to be lined up 4m apart on the start line outside the Scrutineering bay.

Only two bikes at a time in the scrutineering bay with their pilot and their personal protection gear. There are two stations with tables 4 m apart.

Satellite trackers will be installed by the scrutineering team only.

Rally Books & GPS downloads to be issued at scrutineering.

The competitors will present the vehicle and self-declaration scrutineering form to the scrutineer. A scrutineer will check the vehicle and advise (and if necessary, point out) any issues to the competitor.

Socialising is not permitted while you are waiting your turn.

Attendance at scrutineering and results of checks will be recorded on a register kept by the scrutineers along with any faults that require attention.

If the vehicle is passed, then a completed scrutineering sticker will be handed to the competitor to place on the vehicle before departing scrutineering.

Vehicles that fail scrutineering are not permitted to qualify or race until they have been presented again and pass the scrutineering checks. The fault will be noted on the self-declaration scrutineering form. On returning to the scrutineering area, these vehicles will be checked in a separate area, provided that they need not go over the pit again. The area will be advised to the competitor when they are advised that they need to come back to scrutineering.

Sanitizing sprays will be on hand to disinfect hands before leaving the area, but it is recommended that each competitor also have their own.

Competitors and officials are to please treat each other with the necessary respect and any issues are to be dealt with via the correct channels.

Post-event scrutineering and GPS checks may be carried out, if the Clerk of the Course or Stewards deem same to be necessary, subject to social distancing, mask wearing and sanitation protocols being adhered to.

Any technical inspections (whether as a result of a protest or not) must be held at a later date with the part/s in question being properly sealed and stored for safekeeping.

Please also refer to the Programme of Events for an in-person riders briefing on Thursday evening. Social distancing and wearing of masks (covering nose and mouth) to be strictly adhered to.

8. PRE-RACE / PADDOCK / PARC FERMÉ

Social distance must be adhered to.

Competitors to remain on/with their vehicles (motorcycles / quads) as far as possible until assistance is provided.

9. REFUELLING

As per notice board and riders briefing instructions. Onus is on the competitor to place their fuel in the correct bays for the fuel trucks the night before each day.

10. PITS

Team personnel shall confine themselves to their own pit areas, maintaining social distancing measures (no socialising may take place during or after events).

Social distancing must be adhered to at all times.

Masks (covering nose and mouth) to be worn at all times.

12. PROTESTS / APPEALS

All protests and appeals will be dealt with as set out in the club rules, race rules and notices.

In exceptional circumstances, if a hearing has to be held in person the number of people must be limited and all necessary COVID-19 protocols are to be adhered to.

13. PRIZE GIVING

For this event the following will apply:

- Sanitised and individually wrapped trophies will be packed out on a table.
- Riders will collect their trophy from the table when their position is announced.

14. POSTPONEMENT, ABANDONMENT OR CANCELLATION

The organizers reserve the right to cancel the event if less than 100 entries have been received by the closing date.

The Organisers reserve the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the meeting or any part thereof. In the event of any of the above, the Competitor/Entrant has no right to claim against the Promoter/Organiser in respect of any loss or damage S/he may incur.

Should a Force Majeure situation occur – the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event.
